"The Battle Is The Lord's"

"... Thus saith the Lord unto you, be not afraid nor be dismayed by reason of this great multitude; for the battle is not yours, but God's." 2 Chronicles 20:15

The title above is implied throughout the Bible. David also used it in I Samuel 17:47 as he faced the giant Goliath.

In the text, Jehoshaphat was a king in Judah around 850 B.C. and he did that which was right in the sight of the Lord. All was well in his kingdom until he got the word that a great host was coming against him and was only about 40 miles away. In two or three days, this enemy would be at their gates. This was a very serious situation. The (opposing) mighty army was beyond what Jehoshaphat and his army would be able to handle. **Jehoshaphat was afraid.**

Common sense says, "The land is invaded. Don't waste time. Call the army; get the guns; now is the time to prepare to fight." Oh no, not Jehoshaphat. By human standards, He did what made **no sense**. He proclaimed a fast and called a prayer meeting to seek the face of God.

Jehoshaphat prayed one of the most famous prayers in the Bible and concluded by saying, **"... For we have no might against this great company that cometh against us, neither know we what to do, BUT our eyes are upon Thee."**

After that prayer, God spoke through the Prophet Jahaziel and gave Jehoshaphat specific instructions on what to do. They were to march toward the enemy, leading the way with PRAISE. God had said, Praise Me and watch Me work.

In the natural, this seemed like **nonsense**; but this was **God-sense**. As they marched toward the enemy and sang, something began to happen in the enemy's camp. The enemy began to destroy each other until not one of them were left.

When Jehoshaphat and the army of Judah got to the high place overlooking the battlefield (as far as the eye could see) there were dead bodies and stiff corpses all over the hot desert plain.

The battle was over without an arrow being shot, or a spear being thrown. It was just as God had said, "Ye shall not need to fight in this battle" "... For the battle is not yours, but God's." Oh, how they continued to praise God for being true to His Word!



None of us can avoid a crisis or those times of sudden trouble. Job 14:1 says, "Man that is born of a woman is of a few days and full of trouble."

Whether one is a Christian or non-Christian, at times life can be difficult (hitting us with many types of problems and struggles) creating feelings of hopelessness and helplessness. Anyone can say, they believe God, but true character is often revealed when a real problem is being faced.

- How do you handle Heartbreak ~ Sickness ~ Pain ~ Shortages ~ Uncertainty ~ Persecution?
- Do you still Praise God ~ Trust Him ~ Give Him Thanks ~ Read His Word ~ Spend time in Prayer ~ Fellowship with other believers?
- Or do you Panic ~ Complain ~ Deny there is a problem ~ Get mad at God?

If you are in a critical situation which is beyond the power of your resources, strength, or intelligence of what to do, and you only see it as your battle to take care of alone; you are in big trouble. But, if you see it as God's battle, take your position and stand on His Word. God delights to intervene on behalf of powerless people. Seek His face and follow His instructions.

Over and over again, our loving Heavenly Father shows that even through pain and disappointment, **He makes no mistakes**. God has already done so many great things for each of us. We have no reason to doubt Him. Therefore, with present and future struggles, we must believe that God will act and come through for us.

God wants praise before, during, and after the battle. Do this and experience the next level of God's presence and power, which is available for each believer.

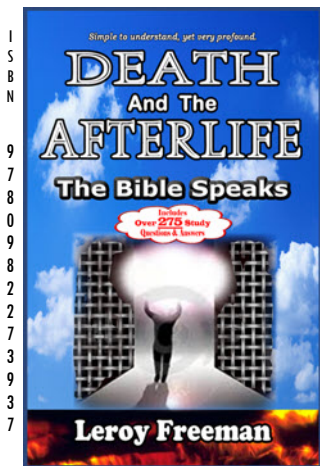
Wow ~ What Good News.
